During 1921 the US government changed the coin design from the "Morgan" style silver dollar to the "Peace" silver dollar. (See separate value guide for US Peace Silver dollars.)									

*Above values reflect the 'average' price based on the market at the time of this printing. (Values are in US dollars.) Silver dollar overdates and certain scarcer Morgan dollar varieties exist for some years. These may bring more than prices on this list. Other factors can also affect or hurt coin values, such as excessive bag marks, polishing, or other damage. The values of these silverdollars (particularly the lower priced coins) often move when an ounce of spot silver rises or decreases in price, or when there are changes in collector supply or demand.

** Morgan Silver Dollars were sometimes minted at different US government mints. No mint mark indicates the coin was minted at the US Philadelphia Mint, CC=Carson City Nevada Mint, D =Denver Colorado mint, O= New Orleans Louisiana Mint, S=San Francisco California Mint. Caution – be careful of counterfeit and altered coins, where unscrupulous individuals fraudulently alter or shave off a mint mark to make the coin appear to be scarcer. Mint marks are located on the coin's reverse under the eagle design.

***About "mintages" and quantities that exist today - The mintage column reflects the number of coins originally made. (Mintage numbers come from various sources, and are sometimes averaged if conflicting numbers exist.) Around 1918 the US government melted an extremely large quantity of silver dollars to extract the silver from them - 270,232,700 coins! No one knows how many of each date or mint mark were melted. Because of this, original coin mintages don't reflect today's scarcity. Some silver dollars with seemly large mintages are difficult to find today, probably because large amounts of those years were melted.

**** Coin grading is subjective . "Uncirculated" mint state coins exist in various degrees of perfection. Uncirculated price is for a typical mint condition coin with normal amount of bag marks or surface blemishes. Better mint condition uncirculated coins will bring considerably more. In some years "proofs" were made at the Philadelphia mint. Most Proof Morgan dollars are scarce and will trade for over \$1,000 if in attractive mint state condition.
